



Jockey Health Information System

The Jockey Health Information System™ (JHIS), a module of the InCompass Race Track Operations (RTO) software, enables a jockey to enter and manage personal health information online. This information will be available to help appropriate healthcare individuals if the jockey is involved in an emergency on the racetrack.

To access and use the secure JHIS module, a jockey must obtain a user name and password from InCompass. The module can be accessed from any computer that runs Internet Explorer 7.0 or higher and has [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) installed.

Jockeys must be 18 years of age or older and have a valid e-mail address to access the JHIS.

Obtaining a User Name and Password

To obtain a user name and password, a jockey must take:

- o valid jockey's or exercise rider's license;
- o photo ID; and
- o completed User Name and Password request form available at the end of the User Guide, found at <http://rto.incompasssolutions.com>

to one of the following locations:

- o InCompass offices at 821 Corporate Dr., Lexington, KY 40503;
- o the Jockeys' Guild offices at 103 Wind Haven Drive, Suite 200, Nicholasville, KY 40356; or
- o the medical office at a participating racetrack.

Once identification has been verified, a user name and password will be provided to the jockey giving them the ability to access the JHIS to enter and update their health information. Phoned, faxed or e-mailed requests from a jockey for a user name and password will not be granted.
